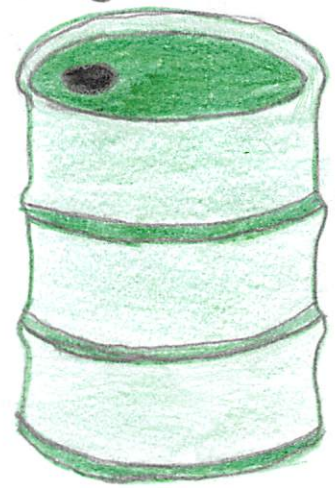
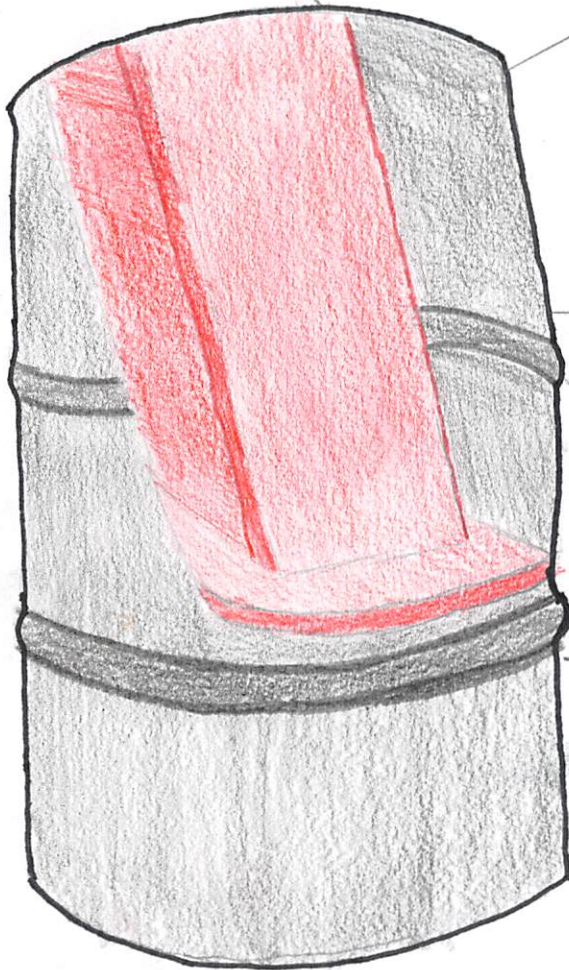


OIL BARREL CHAIR

Step 1: Open the drum
and clean it out use

a strong detergent.

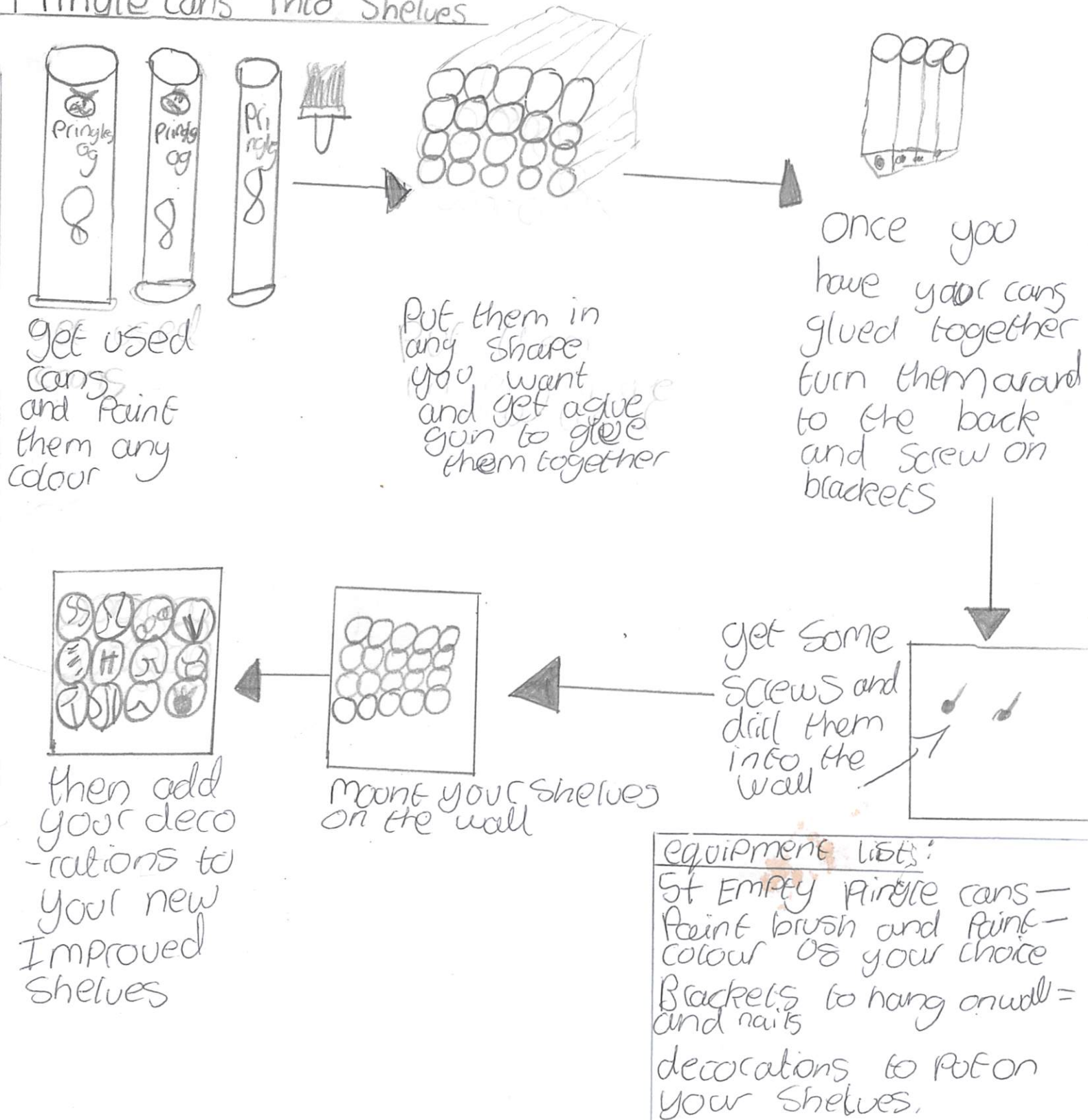
Step 2: Then you need
to mark up and cut
out with angle grinder
Then use grinding wheel
to smooth out edges

Step 3: Weld a 40mm
steel bar 1/3 of the way
up and then clean up
excess left over
metal.

Step 4: Now you will need to build your seat base cut out
2 triangle sections out of ~~MDF~~ MDF with base of 140mm and height
of 530mm. Then cut out an MDF piece with dimensions of 550x
300mm. Then you will need a 572mm diameter base for your
seat. Then tack and glue all together

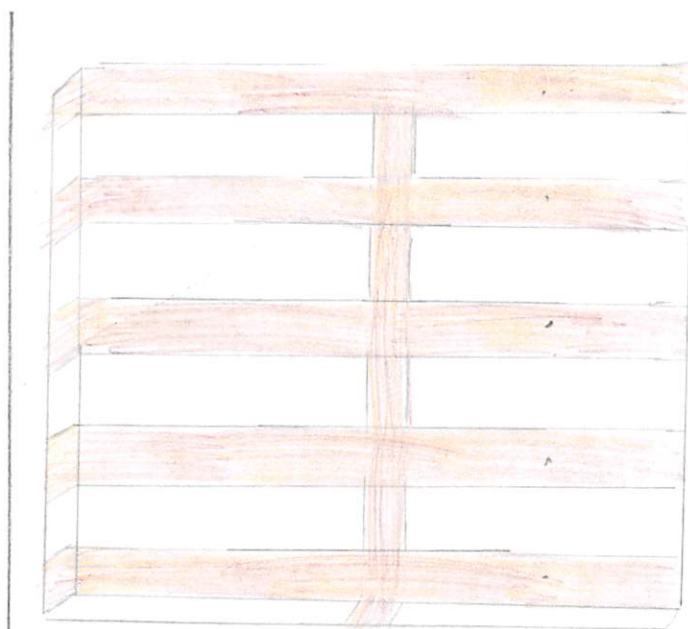

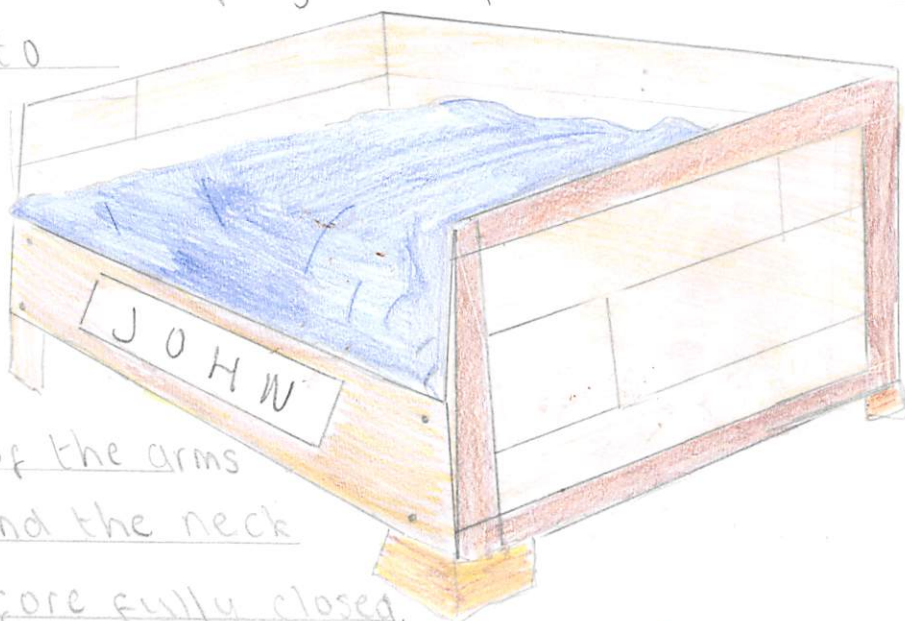
First, saw the wood apart at the join. Make sure to measure what size you want the bed beforehand. Cut the wood to that

size. Use nails and hammer the wood in a rectangle / square shape. Don't forget to put wood on the bottom for the dog to sit on.

Buy some stuffing for the cushion.

Sew the ends of the arms of the jumper and the neck and bottom. Before fully closed,

put the stuffing in. Sew the hole closed and (optional) you can put a sign with your dog's name on too!

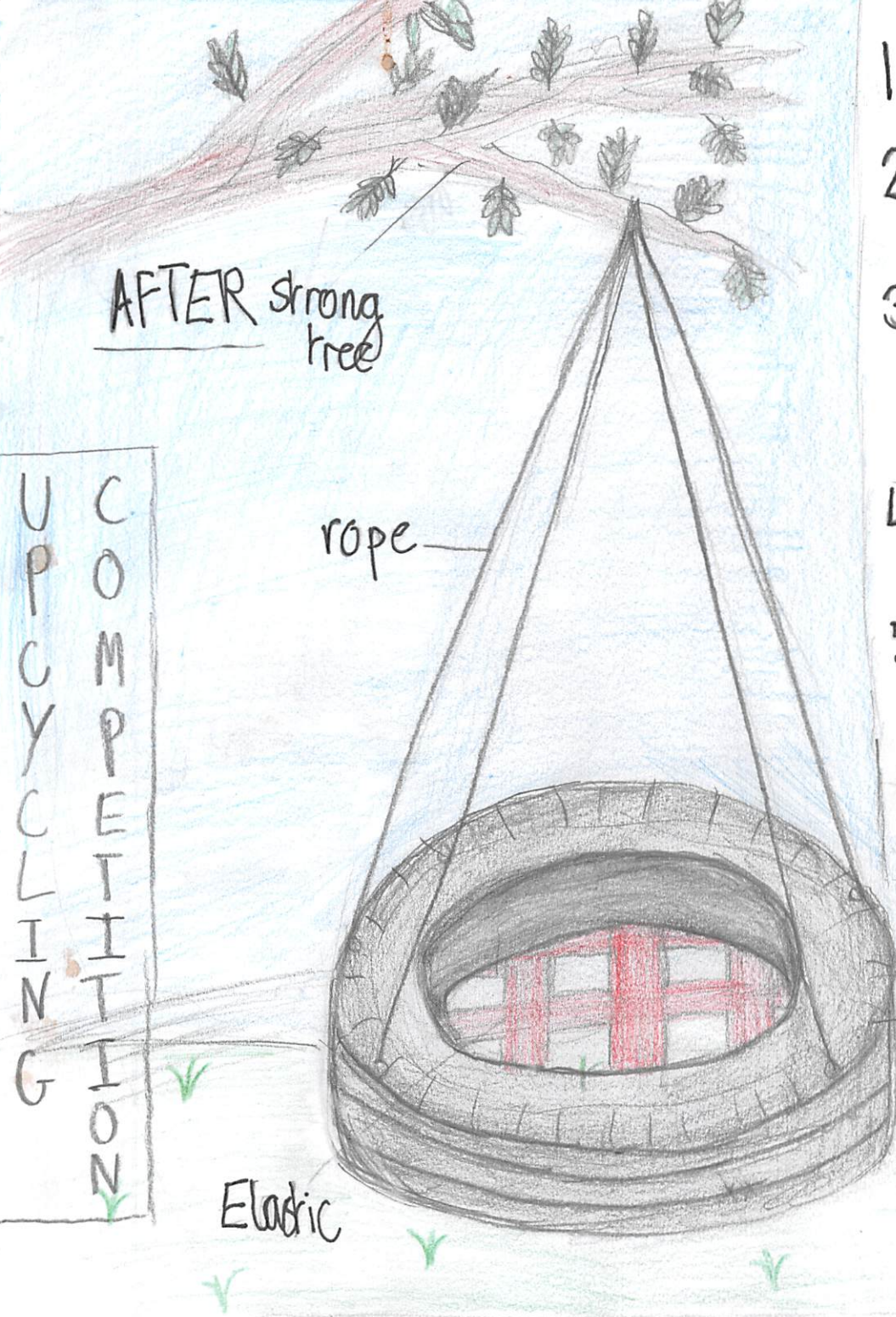

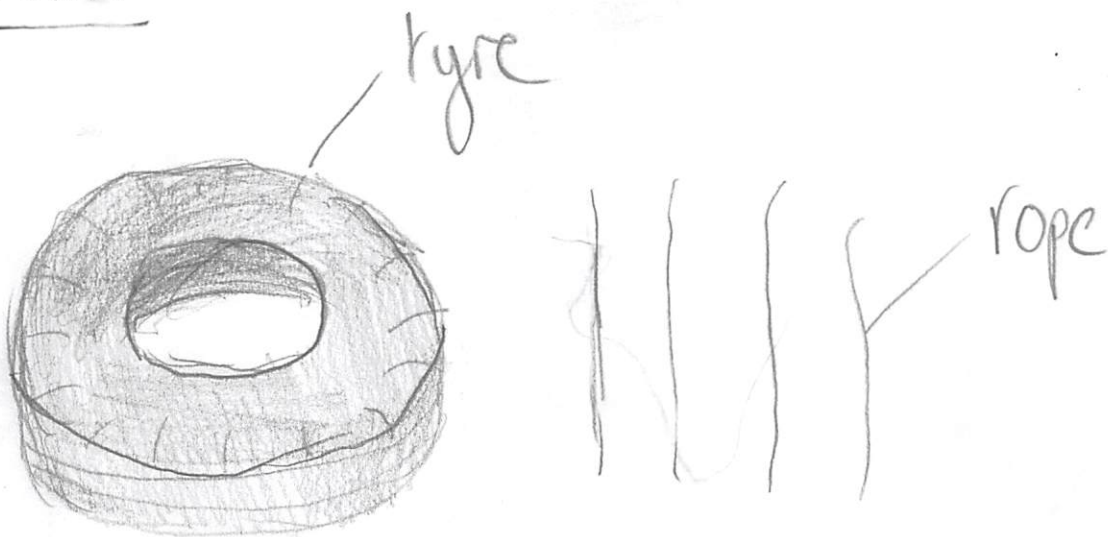

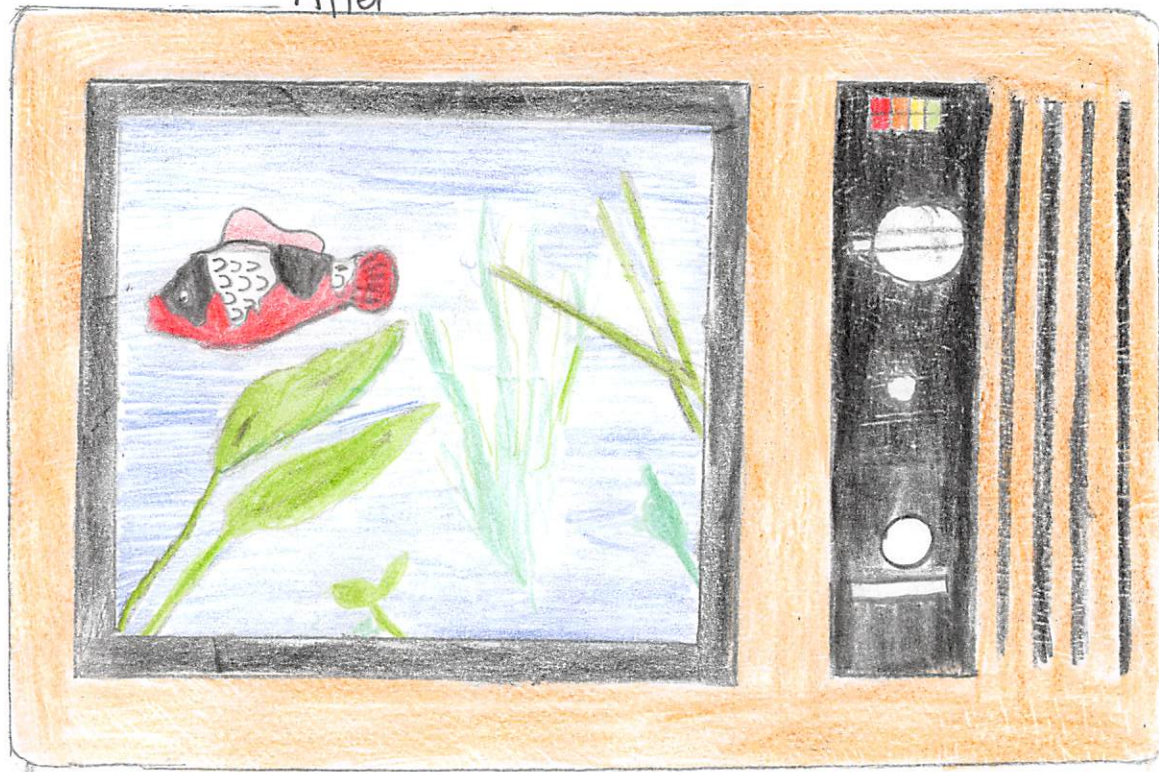
1. Get a used tyre and a rope

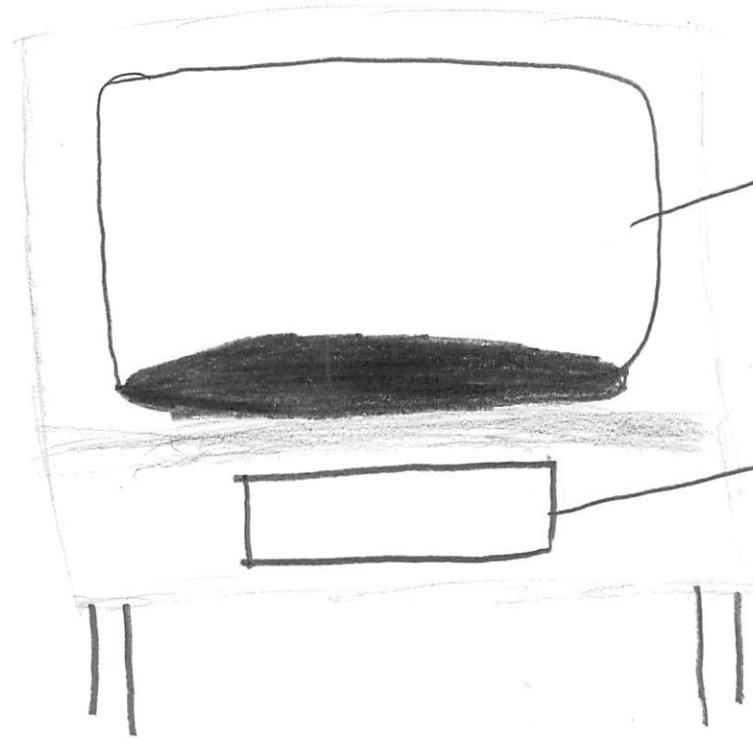

Upcycling is the act of taking something no longer in use and giving it a second life and new function.

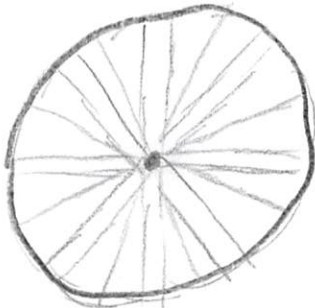
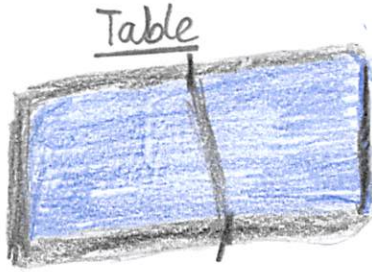

People can transform their unused clothes into pretty bags. It's cheap and fun to make. ~~All~~ there are more ways to upcycle clothes.

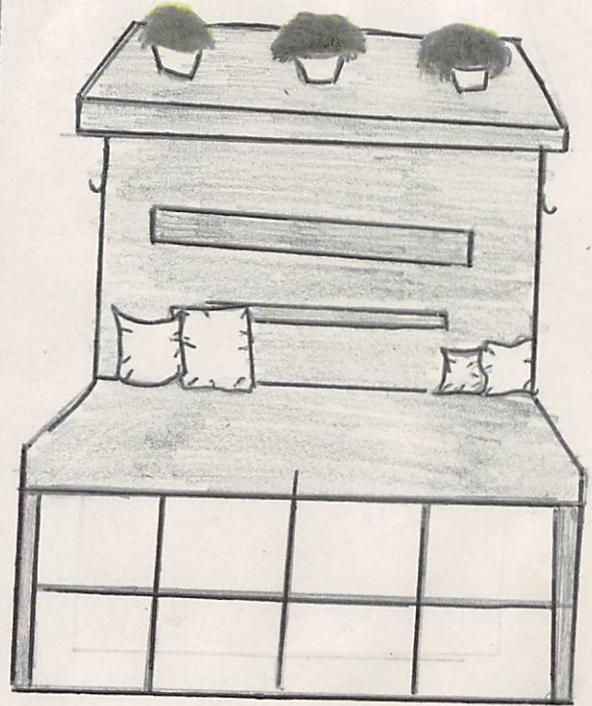

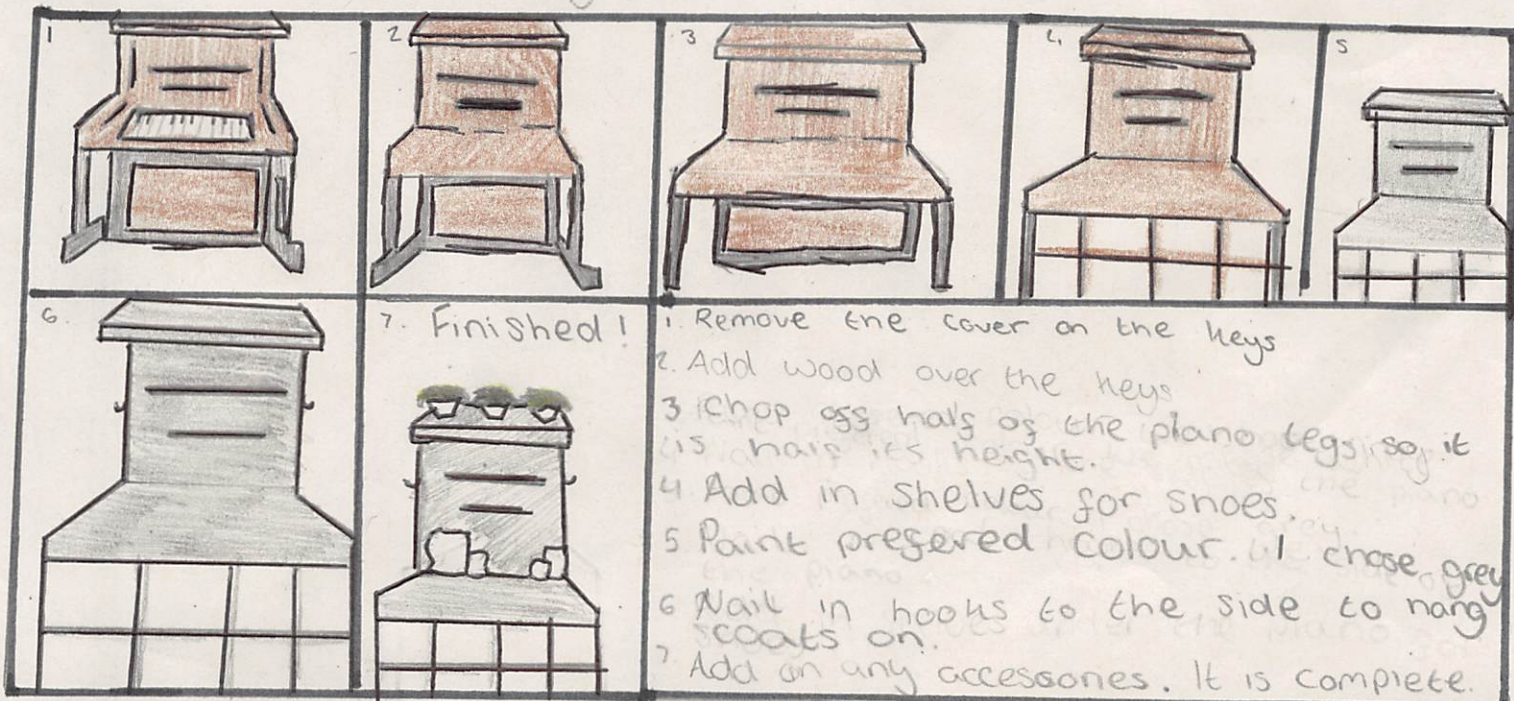

WHAT YOU NEED...

- ✦ jute rope OR string
- ✦ old circular mirror

METHOD...

step 1:

Trace the circumference of the mirror in pencil on the wall where you want it to hang, then mark the center. Divide the circle into 16 equal sections, marking a point where each line meets the circle. Mark off each point with numbered pieces of painter's tape (numbered 1-16), starting with 1 at the top center, moving in a clockwise direction.

step 2:

On each point, measure a (depending on the size of the mirror) 16-inch line going outwards from the star center of the circle. For the smaller point, measure a (depends on the size again) 9-inch line. At the end of line, drill in a nail.

step 3:

Wrap the twine around the nails in the way it shows in the image. Keep doing this until it makes the star.

step 4:

Now you can hang your mirror in the middle of the star.

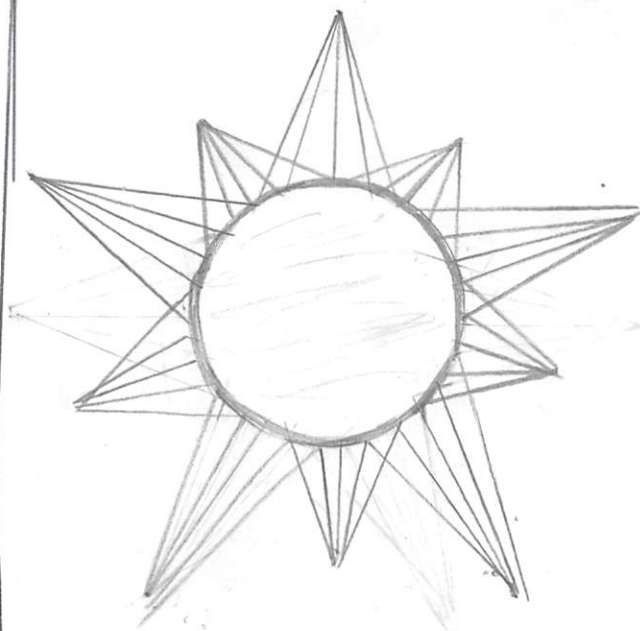

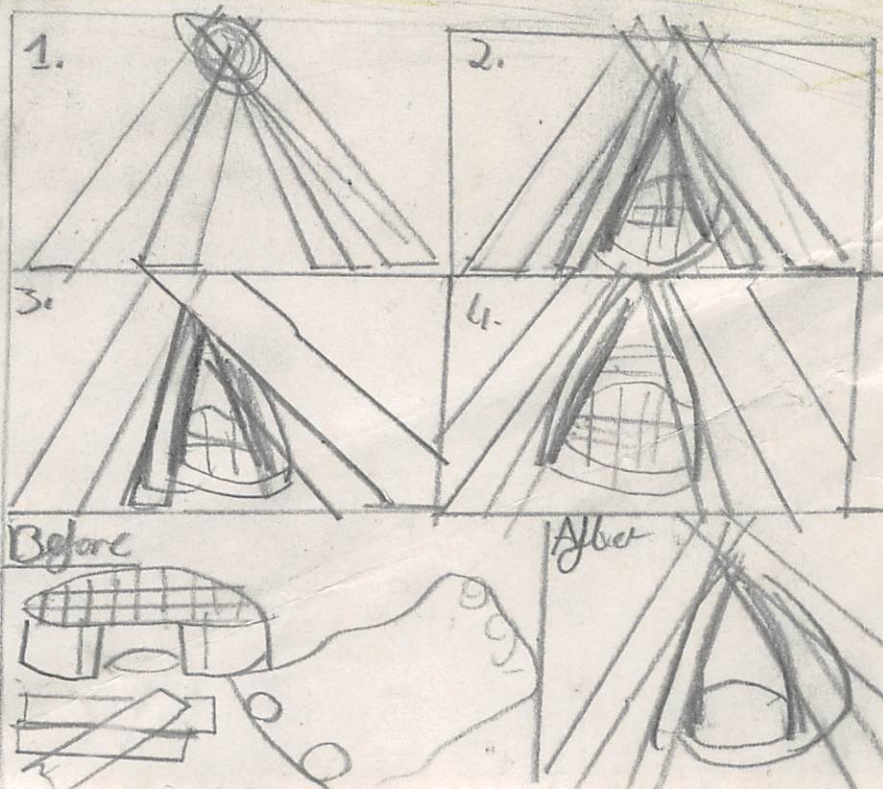


Trampoline Sleep Study

I did not put a light inside the carton as you would not be able to find an old one instead I made mini windows as it is also energy efficient.

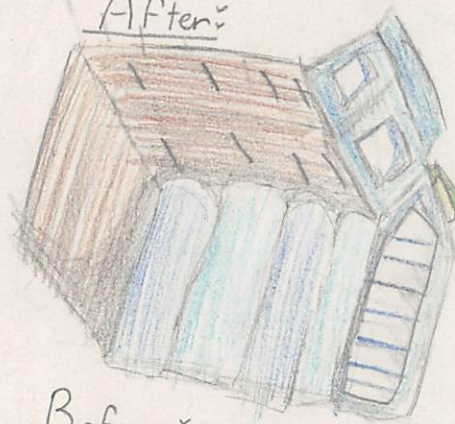
Optional Additions:

- Tie String around it to decorate it.

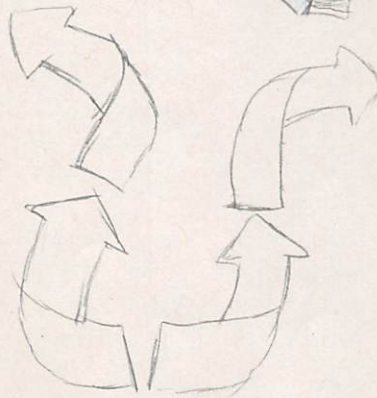
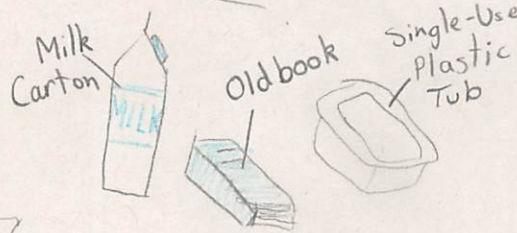

There will be windows on the sides of the milk rack to be able to see inside the Shelving Unit.

Step by Step:

- 1) Cut out the window holes and the centre from the milk carton.
- 2) Saw out gaps for knives to go.
- 3) Slot pieces card into the milk Carton to act as shelves.
- 4) Stick on plastic for windows and stick on the book covers onto the wood block.
